C I R C U L A R

In continuation of CBI Head Office order dated 19.01.2007 and subsequent order dated 16.01.2009 and 06.02.2009 regarding Transfer Policy, the following general guidelines for Law Officers are issued:

LAW OFFICERS

Subject to administrative exigencies, the maximum tenure would be of six years in one branch and 12 years in one station. The minimum tenure in one branch/station would be three years. However, in case of North-East, J&K and Andaman-Nicobar Island, the maximum tenure would be of two years.

Due to practical difficulties faced by the Law Officers with regard to language problem, the condition contained in the circular dated 06.02.2009 regarding transfer of Law Officers from one station to another after completion of 12 years in the same station has been dispensed with in the cases involving language problem and such officers shall be transferred and rotated within the same region.


