**SUBJECT: TENDER FOR PROCUREMENT OF EQUIPMENTS FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF TECHNICAL AND FORENSIC SUPPORT UNITS IN CBI.**

**BACKGROUND:**

The usage of scientific aids, technology and forensics in investigation and prosecution is crucial for the success of a criminal case. CBI being a premier and multi-disciplinary agency is expected to lay special emphasis on technology up-gradation and forensic aid. Accordingly, a Technical, Forensic and Coordination Zone has been established at the CBI, HQ. To provide these technical services, it has been decided to establish "Technical Forensic Support Units (TAFSU) at the 16 Zonal Head Quarters of CBI (Annexure-IV). TAFSU will provide for "on the spot" technical support to investigation and prosecution and speed up the investigation process.

The Bill of Material along with its Technical Specifications may be seen at **Annexure-I** enclosed.

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**INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERER:**

**1. Tender Form**

Tender (Bid) Form consists of various sections and the Tenderer shall go through all the sections of the Tender document and must comply with each section.

## 2. Compliance

- 2.1 Compliance statement in the form of '**Complied**' or '**Not complied**' shall be given against each statement and specification of Tender Form. The compliance statements should be supported by **authentic documentation**.
- 2.2 Any deviation from laid down requirements/specification shall be brought out separately in deviation sheets to be attached with concerned section of the Tender. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in the Tender being invalidated.
- 2.3 The Tenderer shall offer comments about all the requirements indicated in the specifications. The Tenderer shall mention whether the options are technically available in the proposed solution or not. The Tenderer shall clearly mention about the non-availability of the required options in the offer, if any.
- 2.4 Each page of the bid and cuttings, corrections, etc., if any, shall be duly signed and stamped by the Tenderer. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in the Tender being invalidated.

### **GENERAL CONDITIONS:**

The following instructions should be carefully noted:

1. **Tender Document is available for sale with Shri. R.S.Panwar, Assistant Director, IPCC, from January 31, 2012 to February 24, 2012 between 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m.** against Demand Draft/ Banker's Cheque of Rs. 1000/-(Rupees One Thousand Only) drawn in favour of " DDO, CBI, Coordn. Div., New Delhi." The tender document can also be downloaded from [www.cbi.gov.in](http://www.cbi.gov.in). In such case, an amount of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only) in the form of Demand Draft/ Banker's cheque drawn in favour of " DDO, CBI, Coordn. Div., New Delhi" is to be furnished along with the Bid. Non-submission of tender fee would be treated as non-responsive and bid will not be considered.
2. Quotations should be submitted in two separate covers. First cover indicating "**COVER FOR TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION**" shall consist of only technical specifications of the system offered along with literature, pamphlets, drawing, etc. This cover should contain complete technical specifications, make and model, names of supplier/manufacturer and commercial terms etc. of the system offered. Price column in this cover should be kept blank. **TENDER FEE & EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT SHOULD ALSO BE SUBMITTED IN THIS COVER.** Second cover indicating "**COVER FOR PRICE BID**" should contain the same details of first cover as well as price details also. Both the covers should first be sealed separately and then packed in one bigger sealed cover. This cover addressed by name to the officer signing this enquiry should be submitted before the due date and time.
3. Bids should be valid for a minimum period of 180 days from the due date for submission of the bids.

4. Envelope should bear the inscription:-

5. **The Bids must reach the undersigned on or before the due date, i.e., February 24, 2012 by 3.00 p.m.** Bids received after the due date & time are liable to be rejected. In the event of due date being a closed holiday or declared holiday for Central Government offices, the due date for submission of the bids will be the following working day at the appointed time & venue. **Bids received will be opened on the same day, i.e., on February 24, 2012 at 3.30 p.m. in the office of Assistant Director, IPCC, Central Bureau of Investigation, Plot-5B, 6<sup>th</sup> Floor, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi – 110003. Parties participating are requested to be available for opening of bids.**
6. **Clarifications regarding tender document**
- The prospective bidders requiring any clarification about the contents detailed in the tender document may notify CBI in writing (Original/Fax only). Clarification sought by the vendors along with CBI response will be posted on website `www.cbi.gov.in`. Accordingly, all the vendors must refer the above website for clarification, if any, before submission of their bids on the due date/time. Queries/Clarifications will be received and responded as per schedule detailed below:

7. The bidder must be a reputed manufacturer or authorized representative for the type of product offered. In case of representative, the bidder should submit Manufacturer’s/Distributor’s Authorization. The bids received without authority are liable to be rejected.
8. The supplier should be authorized to supply all the major computer forensics hardware and software in India and should be authorized from the Principals directly or should have authorization from the Authorized Distributor of the products in India.
9. **An undertaking from manufacturer is required stating that they would facilitate the Tenderer on regular basis with the technology/product updates and extend support for the warranty and AMC period as well.**
10. **The bidder should be an authorized distributor/retailer/partner of the Original Equipment Manufacturer products and should have adequate facilities,**

**manpower and staff for installation, commissioning and after sales service of the equipments.**

11. Tenderer is duty bound to observe all Laws, Rules, Regulations, Policies, Procedures and Guidelines of the Government of India as in force from time to time.
12. The Articles of Association and Memorandum of Association of the Tenderer are to be submitted along with the certificate of incorporation.
13. The bidder shall provide the Registration number of the firm along with the LST/CST allotted by the Sales Tax authorities in their quotation.
14. The bidder should quote the products strictly as per the tendered specifications. Complete Technical details along with make, model number, specification, pamphlets and literature of the systems highlighting the special features of their offer should be supplied along with the quotation.
15. **Earnest money deposit**
  - 15.1 Each quotation must be accompanied by Earnest Money Deposit of **5% (Five Percent) of the amount of each item** payable in the form of Demand Draft/Pay Order/Bank Guarantee drawn on any Indian Nationalized Bank in favour of “ DDO, CBI, Coordn. Div., New Delhi.” . Bank Guarantee should be valid for a minimum period of 180 days from the due date (original) of submitting the quotations. **Quotations received without Earnest Money Deposit are liable to be rejected.**
  - 15.2 Earnest Money is liable to be forfeited and bids are liable to be rejected, if the tenderer withdraws, amends, impairs or derogates from the tender in any respect within the period of validity of the tender.
  - 15.3 The earnest money of all the unsuccessful tenderers will be returned as early as possible after the expiration of the period of the bid validity but not later than 30 days of the issue of the purchase order. No interest will be payable by CBI on the Earnest Money Deposit.
  - 15.4 The Earnest Money of successful bidder shall be returned after acceptance of the material.
  - 15.5 The Tender Document should be placed in the “TENDER BOX’ placed in the office of the “Assistant Director, IPCC, CBI, Plot no.5-B, 6<sup>th</sup> floor, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi-110 003”.
16. Bidder shall sign all pages of quotation and drawings forwarded with the quotation.
17. The Bidders should give clause-by-clause compliance for the technical specification of the equipments in their technical bids. They shall also give compliance of all the terms & conditions as mentioned in the Tender document.

18. It should be specifically mentioned whether the quotation is strictly as per tender specifications/conditions. If not, deviations must be spelt out specifically. **In the absence of this, the quotation may be rejected.**
19. Bidder should quote for all the items strictly as per the specifications. Price comparison shall be made package wise. Cost of optional items will also be taken into account for price comparison. However, purchase of optional items will be at the discretion of CBI. Quotations not adhering to the specifications will be rejected out right.
20. Rates quoted by the Bidder shall be final.

## **21. Language**

The Tenderer shall quote the rates in English language and international numerals. The rate shall be quoted in whole numbers. These rates shall be entered in figures as well as in words. In the event of the order being awarded, the language of all services, manuals, instructions, technical documentation etc. provided for under this contract, should be English.

22. Demonstration of products, if required, will be required by the technical evaluation committee.
23. The supplier will ensure smooth integration of the proposed equipments at specified locations.
24. The supplier shall supply all installation & commissioning spares and accessories as may be required during erection, initial operation of the facility till successful commissioning at specified location. The supplier will have to arrange/provide for all the testing equipment & tools required for successful installation, testing, acceptance, and maintenance etc.

## **25. Inspection**

CBI representative shall have the right to inspect or to test the items to confirm their conformity to the ordered specifications. The supplier shall provide all reasonable facilities and assistance to the Inspector appointed by CBI at no charge. In case any inspected or tested goods fail to conform to the specifications, CBI may reject them and supplier shall either replace the rejected goods or make all alterations necessary to meet specifications required free of cost.

26. Media CD of the desired forensic tools should be provided along with software/hardware supplied.
27. The supplier shall provide free of cost in-house training to CBI officials at the site in features details, installation, operation and maintenance of the Forensic software/hardware tools. The required training documents shall be circulated well in advance.

28. The equipment must be supported by a Service Centre manned by the suppliers' technical support engineers certified by OEM in India. The support through this Centre must be available for 24 hours a day, seven days a week and 365 days a year. Also there should be arrangement to contact the Principal Supplier's (OEM's) Support Centre on a toll free number/web /email.

**29. Warranty**

The Forensic software/hardware Tools (as contained in Annexure-I) has to be provided with one-year onsite warranty covering total equipment. Warranty period of all equipments shall start after the satisfactory installation, commissioning, functioning, operation, acceptance and handing over of the entire work at desired location. Warranty shall include free maintenance of the whole equipment supplied including free replacement of parts. It shall include free support and upgrades for three years.

**36. Delivery period**

**The delivery is required within three weeks of placement of the purchase order.** Any delay by the supplier in the performance of delivery of items shall render the supplier liable to any or all of the following sanctions-forfeiture of its Earnest Money Deposit, imposition of liquidated damage as per para 45 below or/and cancellation of the purchase order for default. In that case, the proposed supplier shall also be liable to make good the loss suffered by making payment of penalty to **CBI**.

**37. Performance security**

The successful bidder shall submit a Performance Security of 10% of the cost of the equipment within 15 days of the placement of purchase order. The Performance Security may be in the form of Demand Draft/Pay Order/Bank Guarantee of any Indian Nationalized Bank. The Bank Guarantee should be valid for a minimum period of 12 months extendable to cover warranty period. In case supplier fails to deliver the items within delivery period or provide satisfactory after sales service within the warranty period, the Performance Security submitted by him is liable to be forfeited. Performance Security shall be released immediately after the warranty is over. No interest will be payable by CBI on the Performance Security.

38. Equipments are required to be directly supplied at specified 16 locations (**Annexure – IV**) in India for installation by supplier. All the expenses involved in shipping the equipment to the desired location will be borne by the Bidder. All aspects of safe delivery shall be the exclusive responsibility of the Bidder. CBI will have the right to reject the component/equipments supplied, if it does not comply with the specifications at any point of installation/inspections.

39. The rates should be quoted in Indian Rupees inclusive of Govt. Levies like Sales Tax, VAT, Service Tax etc.; Freight, Packaging & Forwarding charges, Entry Tax/Octroi etc, if any, for delivery at the 16 premises of CBI. All prices shall be fixed and shall not be subject to escalation of any description. The rates must be quoted strictly as per the Performa provided in **Annexure-II**.

40. CBI reserves the right to accept or reject any bid or cancel the tender proceedings without assigning any reason whatsoever.
41. Incomplete quotations are liable to be rejected.
42. In case of any discrepancy between rates mentioned in figures and words, the latter shall prevail.
43. CBI may waive any minor infirmity or may seek any clarification, if so desired.
44. Any attempt of negotiation direct or indirect on the part of the tenderer with the authority to whom he has submitted the tender or authority who is competent finally to accept it after he has submitted his tender or any endeavor to secure any interest for an actual or prospective tenderer or to influence by any means the acceptance of a particular tender will render the tender liable to be excluded from consideration.
45. **Liquidated damages**  
  
If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods or complete the installation within the period specified in the purchase order, CBI shall without prejudice to other remedies, deduct as liquidated damage one per cent of the price of the ordered goods for every week or part thereof.
46. All transactions under this document and project are subject to jurisdiction of Delhi only.
